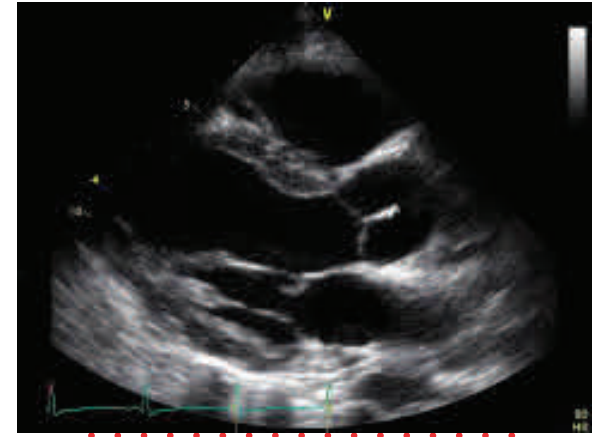


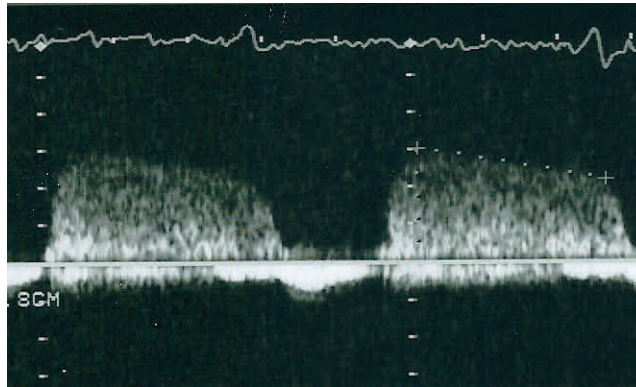

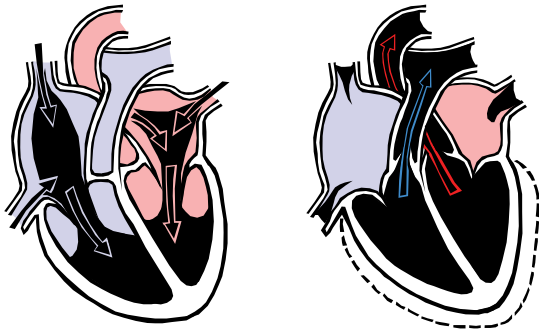
Adult Echocardiography Review Seminar
