Project Title: (56 characters max)	Accessing the evidence to inform practice
Hypothesis:	Compared to the pre-module scores, the students' knowledge scores will be higher after completing the educational modules.
Description: (Include design, methodology, data collection, techniques, data analysis to be employed, evaluation and interpretation methodology for research component)	Registered dietitian nutritionists (RDNs) need to know how to access the evidence to inform their practice in clinical and applied nutrition and dietetics. This project will create educational modules that teach RDNs and aspiring RDNs what tools are available and how to access current evidence to apply in nutrition practice. This summer research will develop the modules, plus create a question bank that will be used to test pre and post module knowledge by comparing scores using a paired sample t-test. The modules will be incorporated into MSCN for Aspiring Dietitians curriculum for the fall 2023 semester.
Specific Student Responsibilities:	The summer student intern will work with the faculty to develop the educational content and create a Canvas course to house the modules. They will also build multiple choice questions to use in the pre- and post-tests to assess change in knowledge.
