Project Title: (56 characters max)	Asian American Family and mental health
Hypothesis:	Conflicts with parents over sexuality and Asian values would influence a young-adult child's sexual guilt. The level of self-differentiation and autonomy from parents would influence a young-adult child's sexual guilt. Sexual guilt, overall, would influence a young adult's mental health.
Description: (Include design, methodology, data collection, techniques, data analysis to be employed, evaluation and interpretation methodology for research component)	This quantitative study will be conducted by collecting cross-sectional data from young adults who are second generation Asian Americans via online survey to answer the above research question. The survey link will be distributed to college Asian American associations and Asian churches across USA by the researchers via email. The research team will continue data collection until a sufficient number of responses are collected ($n = 250$). Once the data are collected, they will be analyzed to test the model from the research question, utilizing structural equation modeling (SEM). The model fit and path loadings will be tested to answer the above research questions.
