Hypothesis:	We hypothesize that integrated Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (I-CBT) that incorporates input from peers with lived experience, with attention to stigmatized beliefs towards self and community members, exploration of the students' preferences on disclosure, educational materials on appropriate accommodations for PTSD and psychiatric conditions in educational settings, in order to address the functional goal of educational functioning will be effective.
Description: (Include design, methodology, data collection, techniques, data analysis to be employed, evaluation and interpretation methodology for research component)	This study evaluates the feasibility and effectiveness of integrated Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (I-CBT), a telehealth assisted CBT intervention for PTSD that incorporates input from peers with lived experience, with attention to stigmatized beliefs towards self and community members, exploration of the students' preferences on disclosure, educational materials on appropriate accommodations for PTSD and psychiatric conditions in educational settings, in order to address the functional goal of educational functioning. In this study, 114 college students with psychiatric disabilities will be recruited, enrolled in the study, and complete the telehealth CBT intervention. This study will collect data on student's vocational, educational, and psychological outcomes as a result of completing the telehealth CBT
