Project Detail:	
Project Title: (56 characters max)	Review ways to improve breast screening uptake for women in Wolverhampton Southeast Population, United Kingdom (UK)
Hypothesis:	National breast screening invites are sent to all women between 50-53 years of age in UK and every 3 years after. The uptake in Southeast Locality in Wolverhampton has traditionally been poor. The aim of the pilot study was to see if joint working between primary care and public health will make a difference to screening uptake and health promotion in the area. We intend to see if the joint working helps address health inequalities and health promotion in the specific demography in Southeast. Secondarily it may provide information on the advantages (if any) of such a mode in the early detection and resolution of any breast cancer events.
Description: (Include design, methodology, data collection, techniques, data analysis to be employed, evaluation and interpretation methodology for research component)	 The methodology for the project is planned to be as follows: Determine the number of invites sent out by public health and primary care (joint working mode) with regards to breast screening in the local area(s) Associate the above with information on the mode of communication i.e. telephone/letter/text/etc., to determine the most effective route or means of improving screening rates.

	 Compare the breast screening rates or numbers from the joint working mode with those available from national screening data sources to determine the effectiveness of the joint working mode. Determine also the time taken between communication and a breast screening event and associate it with the means of communication as also the possibilities for early detection and resolution of any suspicious aspects arising from the screening diagnoses. Overall, the goal is to determine the effectiveness of the joint working mode in improving the breast screening rates in the subject area. Secondarily it may provide information on the advantages (if any) of such a mode in the early detection and resolution of any breast cancer events
Specific Student Responsibilities:	 Specific student responsibilities include: 1. Performing comprehensive literature review of both peer-reviewed and published as also white papers around joint working. Help with analysis of data Prepare a project report detailing all the above as also prepare a Poster for Research Day and a manuscript as per an identified journal's requirements.
