Project Title: (56 characters max)	Cancer prevention and control among Hispanics
Hypothesis:	Hypothesis: We will be able to identify factors and correlates associated with multiple health behaviors (e.g., healthy eating, skin examination, patient-provider communication), media use and technology use for health, and skin cancer prevention among Hispanics.
Description: (Include design, methodology, data collection, techniques, data analysis to be employed, evaluation and interpretation methodology for research component)	To investigate relationships among skin cancer risk and protection with Hispanic cultural values. Collect quantitative data (national survey) from Hispanic individuals in the US to identify cultural values and lifestyle factors related to their sun protection, skin self-examination, and their perceptions of a proposed mobile skin cancer intervention. Evaluation of the intervention includes preferences for the mobile platform, intervention title/logo, and intervention-related materials, such as texts and multimedia content.
Specific Student Responsibilities:	The student will assist the faculty member in the conduct of the faculty member's multiple research studies. Among the key duties for this position are the following: responsible for providing research activities support to the faculty member, such as participants recruitment (contact participants), screening, and enrollment in accordance with federal, state and institutional guidelines, protocol development, data collection, various types of record
