2025 Annual Symposium <u>"Frontiers in Biomedical and Health AI:</u> <u>applications, challenges, and opportunities"</u>

Abstract Submission Requirements

Researchers and trainees are invited to submit a one-page abstract on cutting edge research in the field of Biomedical Informatics and Health AI. Abstracts will be selected for poster or oral presentations at the Rutgers Health AI symposium. The theme for this year is: "Frontiers in Biomedical and Health AI: applications, challenges, and opportunities".

The total word count of the abstract body may not exceed 350 words (excluding spaces) and should include:

- 1. A succinct title
- 2. Scientific summary of the research (Background, Methodology, Results, Conclusion)

A maximum of 1 image (table/figure) is not necessary but can be included per abstract in JPG/PNG format only, as an independent upload. Table/Image/Graph must be legible.

The presenting and lab lead (PI) authors should be indicated. All co-authors should have agreed to be listed on the abstract. When using abbreviations, spell the full name out on first mention and follow with the abbreviation in parentheses. Use of unfamiliar abbreviations may be grounds for rejection unless definitions are supplied in the abstract.

All abstracts must be submitted by 5:00 pm EST, Tuesday, April 15, 2025. If not submitted by this date, your abstract will not be considered. All abstracts will be peer reviewed for scientific rigor and relevance to the Symposium theme to be selected for poster/presentation.
