Analysis of Safety Events in Mental Health Medical Devices.

Hypothesis:

- Issues regarding computing technology are closely linked to a significant number of mental health medical device failures reported to the FDA. The current classification codes in the MAUDE database do not adequately capture these underlying technological problems, potentially underestimating their impact on patient safety and device effectiveness.

Description:

- Data Collection: Data will be collected from the FDA's MAUDE (Manufacturer and User Facility Device Experience) database, focusing specifically on mental health medical device failures.
- Design: Natural Language Processing (NLP) models will be designed and developed to automatically identify and classify computing technology-related failures within the narrative descriptions of device failures.
- Evaluation: The performance of the NLP models will be evaluated using standard metrics such as accuracy, precision, recall, and F1 score.
