Project Title: (56 characters max)	Food is Medicine Newark – A Lifestyle Medicine Trial
Hypothesis:	Individuals with CMKD who are enrolled in a lifestyle medicine (LM) program will demonstrate superior functional improvement to a control group or a Food is Medicine (FIM) program.
Description: (Include design, methodology, data collection, techniques, data analysis to be employed, evaluation and interpretation methodology for research component)	Cardiometabolic Kidney Disease (CMKD) is highly prevalent in underserved urban areas such as Newark, NJ. CMKD can be managed and even reversed via lifestyle changes such as diet/nutrition and physical activity. However, implementation of lifestyle change support is challenging. The purpose of this project is to test the effectiveness of a group lifestyle change session compared to medically tailored groceries and usual care.
