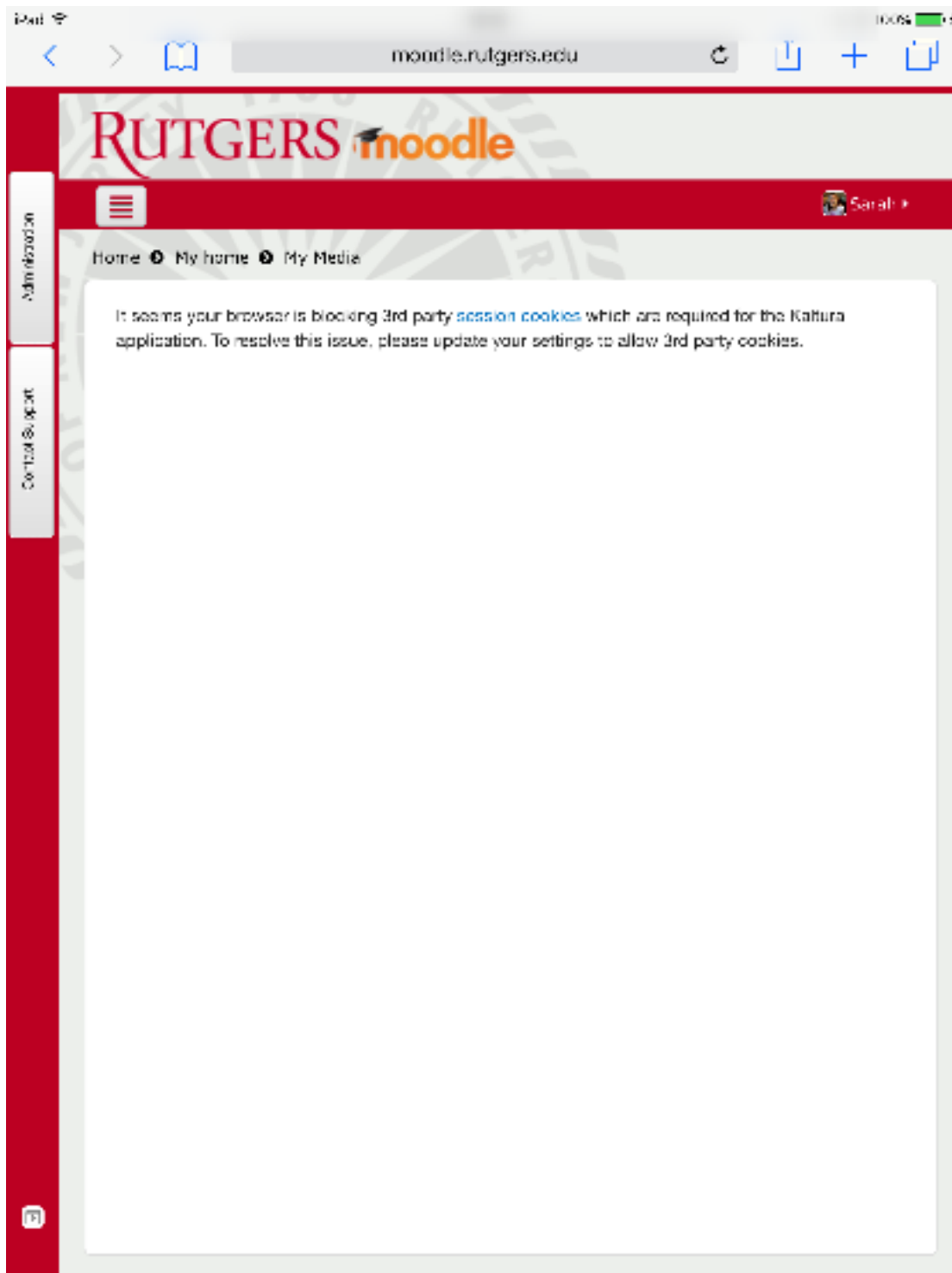


Moodle - Kaltura - Enabling Third Party Cookies in Safari (iPad)

At the end of this document, users will be able to configure their Safari browser to access Kaltura in Moodle.

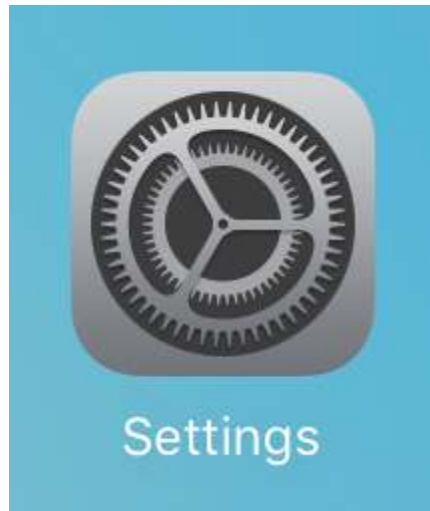
Error Message



If you receive this error when trying to access Kaltura via Safari, you will need to adjust your cookie settings in Safari.

Kaltura is a tool that is located within Moodle, which is why it is asking for additional access.

Find your Settings Icon



Find the **Settings** icon on your iPad. Tap it to open it.

Access the Safari Settings

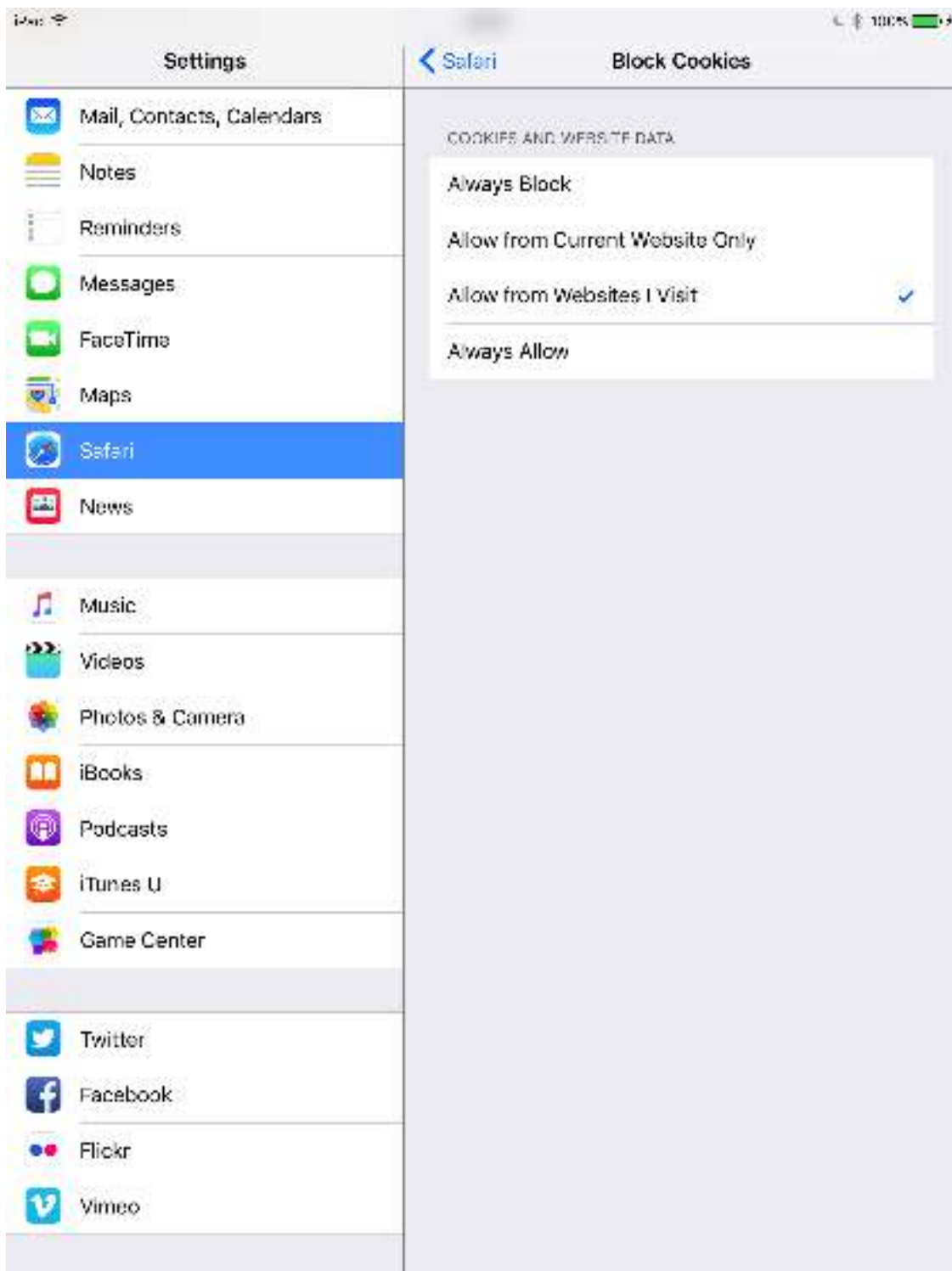


Find the **Safari** settings menu item.

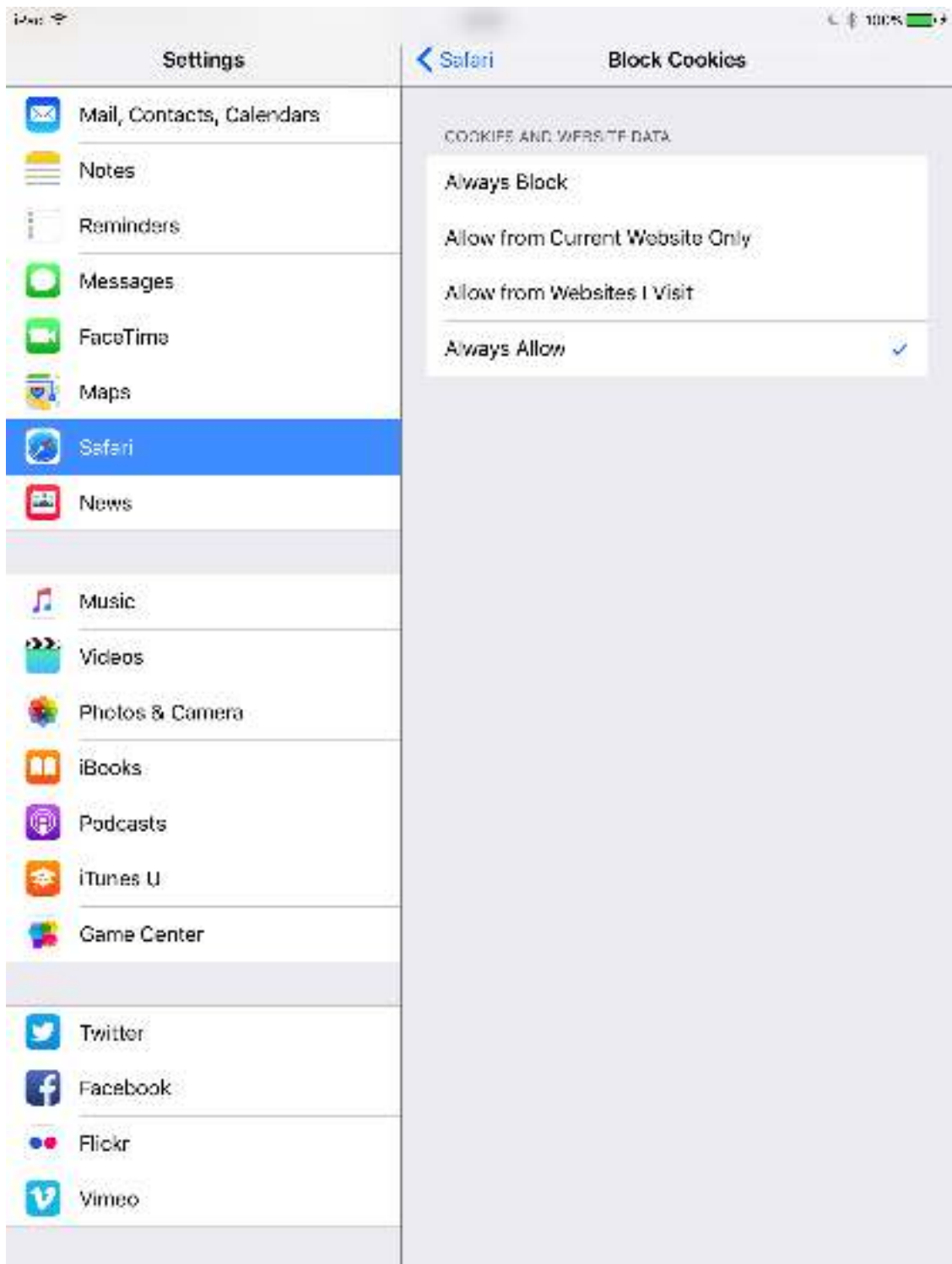


Find the **Privacy and Security Settings** menu option and click on **Block Cookies**.

Changing the Cookie Setting

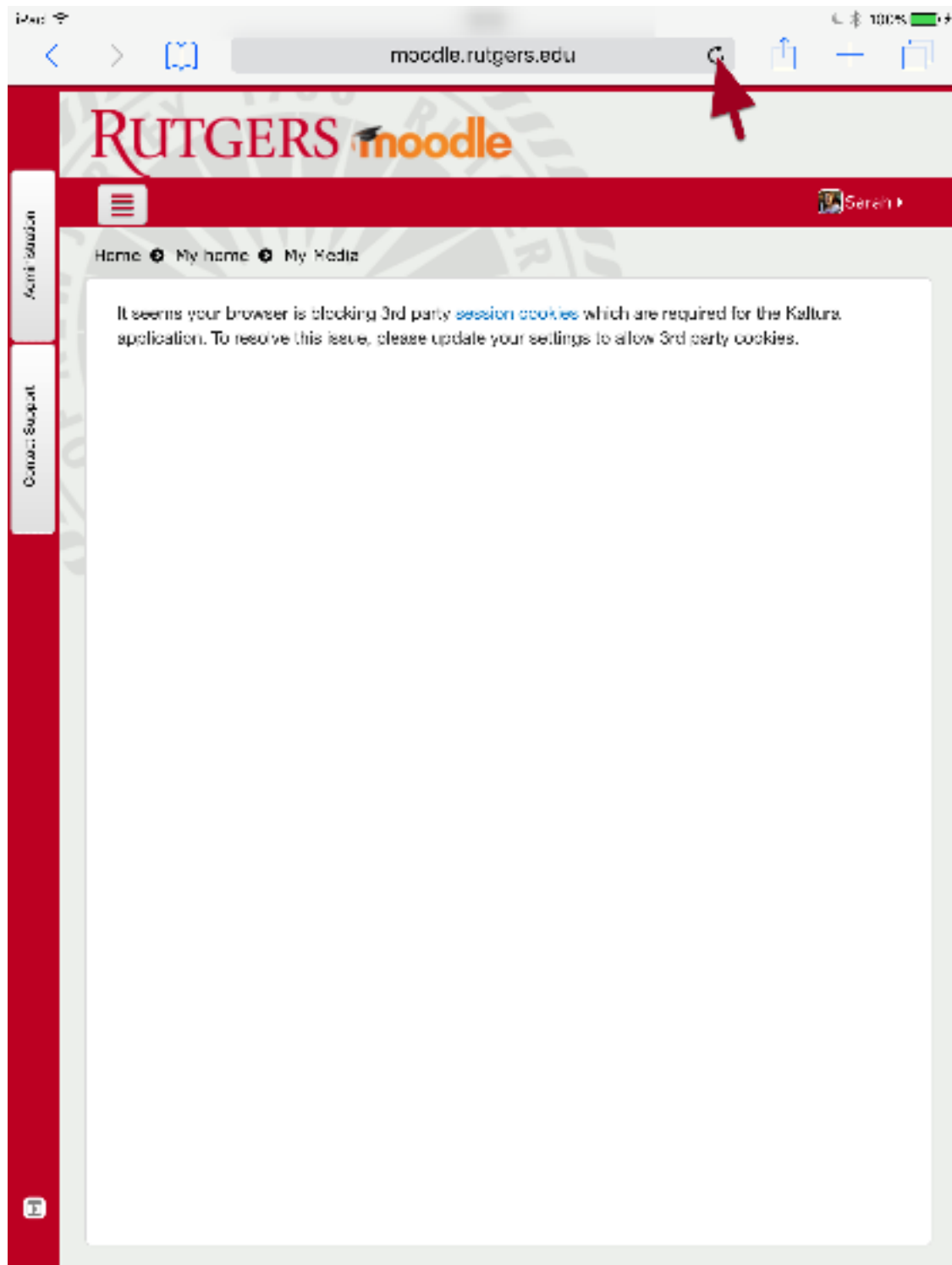


The default is usually set to **Allow from Websites I Visit**. Normally, that would be enough, but because of how Kaltura "talks" to Moodle, we need to change the setting.

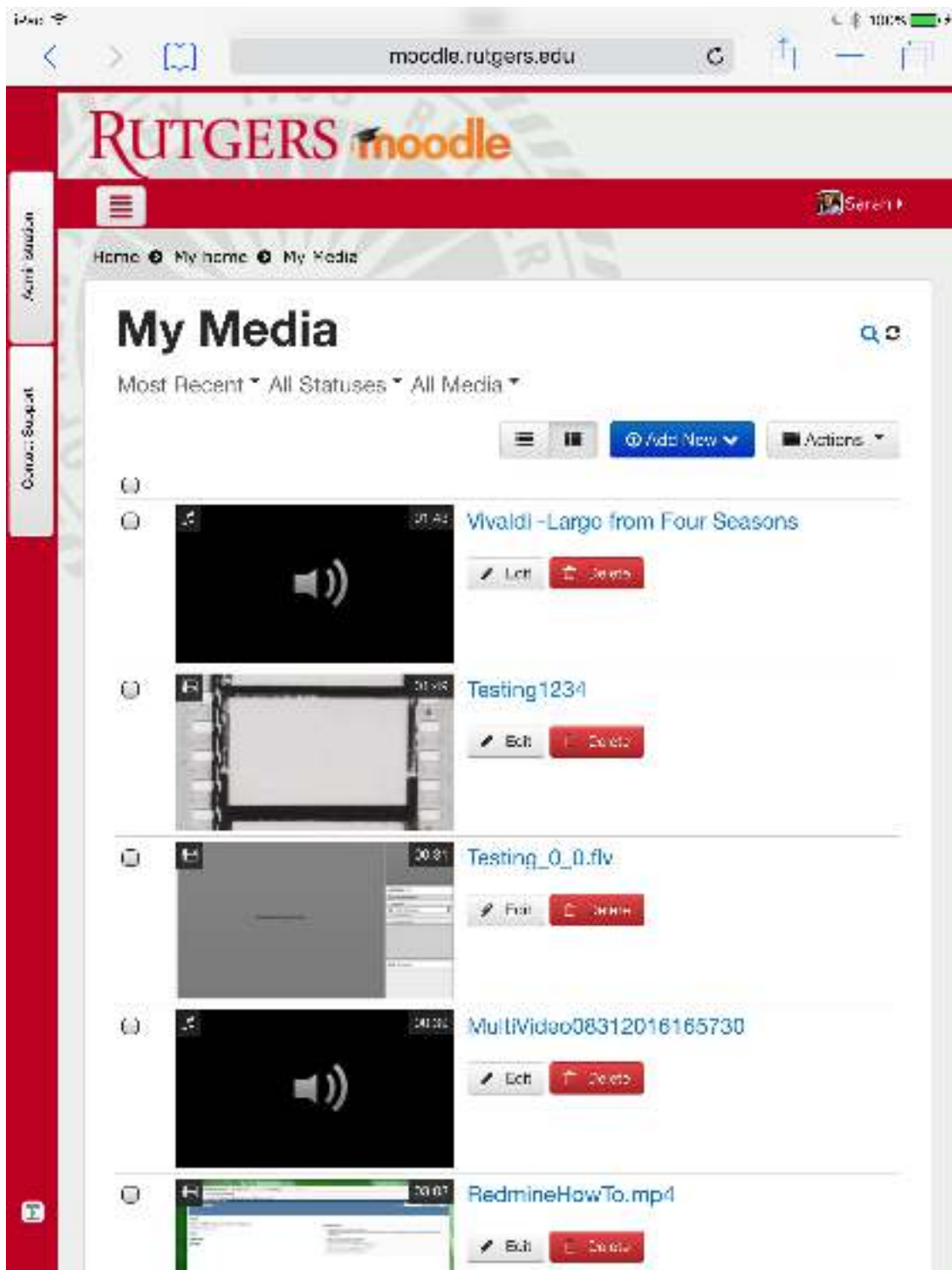


Select **Always Allow** by tapping on the item. A checkbox should appear next to it.

Refresh Safari



Return to Safari. Press the **Refresh** icon to refresh the page.



Kaltura will then load.
