Hypothesis:	DCPNS alumni contribute to scholarship and leadership in the field of nutrition and dietetics

Specific Student Responsibilities:	The student will develop the survey content in collaboration with faculty. They will then format the questions in Qualtrics. We will then conduct an informal pilot among a subset of faculty who are program alumni. The student will administer the survey, collect the results, and analyze the outcomes in aggregate. The student will prepare highlights to share with program directors and assist in updating marketing materials and website.
